Comments on Research:

Based on the large body of research on the type and intensity of radiation coming out of Smart Meters, many public health organizations, health professionals and researchers have been calling for a Moratorium on Smart Meters until they can be proven safe for human use. The overwhelming evidence shows that they cannot be proven to be safe, and the government funded National Toxicology Program found that this type of microwave radiation causes cancer. These meters are also more prone to fires and explosions.

Utilities would like to install these untested devices as they would financially gain from not needing meter readers, have remote disconnect abilities, be able to collect detailed customer data, and in the future charge more for peak hours usage. However, for consumers and for humanity, there are no real benefits, only risks. Smart Meters are part of the Smart Grid and Internet of Things (IoT) Agenda 21/2030.

Our U.S. and Montana Constitutions protect our constitutional rights to privacy and our rights to a “clean and healthful environment”. Charging an Opt-out fee for Smart meters is like charging an extortion fee to prevent from being surveilled, harmed and irradiated. Charging an Opt-out fee for Smart Meters is like charging a monthly fee to buy back our constitutional rights.
